is seeking to appoint a

Professor (W 2) in Business Administration (focus on Accounting and Controlling)

to start as soon as possible.

Key role of this professor is teaching on the BA programme "Business Administration with Informatics", which is taught completely in English and addresses an international audience. Although primary focus is on the areas accounting and controlling, the applicant should also be able to teach other areas of Business Administration with an international perspective.

Further courses should be taught on the Master's Degree "Electronic Systems and Engineering Management" (in English) as well as on other degree programmes if the need arises. It is also expected that the successful candidate will be involved in the further development of existing courses as well as the conceptualisation of new courses at the interface of Business Administration, Applied Informatics and Technology.

Since the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences cooperates closely with regional industry, the successful candidate will participate in this cooperation alongside his or her practice-oriented teaching in the framework of technology transfer and applied research and development. Furthermore, a willingness to pursue external funding and implement research projects as well as involvement in the self-administration of the University is expected.

The applicant must have completed a degree in Business Administration and a PhD with distinction in a related area and must demonstrate professional experience spanning several years in an international, industry-oriented setting.

Qualifications:

- University degree in Business Administration
- Teaching and assessment skills
- Research and publication record showing capability to attain levels commensurate with international status
- Five years of relevant professional experience, at least three of which must have been spent outside academia.

After interim review after a one-year probationary period the successful candidate will be offered an unlimited contract (full-time as well as part-time is possible), subject to fulfilment of the legal requirements.

If needed, the successful candidate may be expected to teach at the other University campuses (Hagen, Iserlohn and Meschede) as well as in the work-study programme.

The South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences is committed to increasing the number of women in teaching and research and thus expressly encourages women to apply. The Equality Act of North Rhine Westphalia accords priority to women with the same eligibility, qualifications and professional record. Applications from persons with disabilities (according to § 2, part 3, section 1 SGB IX) are also desired.
